

LEGAL TERMS FOR PARTICIPATION:

2nd PAEDIATRIC AND MATERNAL HEALTH INVESTMENT FORUM

1. FORUM ORGANISERS:

The Barcelona Medical Association (hereinafter, “**CoMB**”), as promoter of the “CoMB MedAngels Investor Network”, with registered office at Passeig de la Bonanova, 47, Barcelona (08017) and CIF Q0866001A, the Sant Joan de Déu Research Foundation as coordinating entity of the i4KIDS initiative (hereinafter, “**i4KIDS**”) with registered office at Carrer Santa Rosa 30-57, 4th floor, SJD Paediatric Cancer Center Building, 08950 Esplugues de Llobregat (Barcelona), CIF G62978689, Montana Children’s Health Innvierte - SHIP2B VENTURES SGEIC, S.A. (hereinafter “**Montana Children’s**”), with registered office at Vía Augusta, 9, 4-2, 08006 Barcelona, CIF A01876572, and The Child Lens with registered office at Via Laietana, 26, 08003, Barcelona, CIF: B24811051 (hereinafter, “TCL”) are the organisers of the Second Paediatric and Maternal Health Investment Forum (hereinafter, the “**Organisers**”), which will be governed in accordance with these legal terms.

The “CoMB MedAngels Investor Network” is a network of individuals or legal entities with investment interests (formed by CoMB members and other profiles) who want to invest in small and medium-sized companies carrying out innovative projects in the health sector. The Network is promoted by the Innovation and Entrepreneurship Area of CoMB and managed by MEDITECNOLOGIA S.A.U (100% owned by GRUP MED CORPORATIU S.A.U, parent company fully owned by CoMB).

i4KIDS is a Paediatric Innovation Hub, coordinated by the Sant Joan de Déu Research Foundation (FSJD) and the SJD Barcelona Children’s Hospital (HSJD), aimed at promoting and supporting innovation projects in foetal, paediatric and maternal health that stand out for their ability to generate positive social impact and offer solutions adapted to the paediatric population. It includes more than 60 members and associated entities as well as 110 research groups to foster the development of innovation and research projects in paediatrics and maternity to improve diagnoses and treatments. It accomplishes its impact structuring its activities in specific programs tailored to help the development of innovative projects in the field. Remarkably, it has created an acceleration program and actively collaborates with entities, patients, hospitals, companies, and professionals in the sector to carry out open innovation programs addressing

unmet clinical needs. Annually, it organises the Paediatric Innovation Day as well as various training activities for the research and innovation community. It also leads to the i4KIDS-EUROPE network, with the aim of connecting, expanding, and driving the European paediatric and maternal ecosystem.

Montana Children's Health Innvierte is the first European innovation and technology transfer fund exclusively dedicated to child health. Created to cover the historic gap in investment for paediatric diseases and medical needs, Montana Children's identifies, finances, and supports projects with high potential impact on children's lives. The fund works closely with hospitals, research centres, and startups to transform scientific discoveries into concrete clinical solutions, accelerating their journey from laboratory to patient and fostering an unprecedented paediatric innovation ecosystem in Europe.

The Child Lens is a company engaged in strategic consulting and the development of investment opportunities in children health, specialising in the valorisation of innovation projects, company creation, and support in financing strategies and technology transfer within the paediatric biomedical field.

HUS and The New Children's Hospital Foundation (“**Collaborating Entities**”) will host the event.

2. PURPOSE:

The Second Paediatric and Maternal Health Investment Forum (hereinafter, the “**Forum**”) is an initiative by the Organisers to connect startups in the paediatric and maternal health sector with investors interested in seed-stage projects, with the aim of consolidating the paediatric and maternal health innovation ecosystem in Europe.

This call is open to legally incorporated companies seeking pre-seed or seed funding for their project. From the total number of applications submitted by participating companies (hereinafter, “**Participating Companies**”), up to six companies (hereinafter, “**Finalist Companies**”) will be selected to present their project to investors from the CoMB's MedAngels Investor Network, Montana Children's, other Business Angels Networks and *venture* capital firms interested in this subsector.

The Forum may include pre-arranged one-to-one meetings between Finalist Companies and selected investors. The Organisers will facilitate the scheduling of

such meetings but do not guarantee attendance, level of engagement, investment interest or follow-up.

Participation in a 1-1 meeting does not imply any commitment to invest, enter into negotiations, or pursue further discussions. Any subsequent interaction or agreement between a company and an investor will be conducted independently and under the sole responsibility of the parties involved, without liability for the Organisers, and without prejudice to any applicable membership terms or fee arrangements previously accepted by the participating companies.

3. TERRITORIAL SCOPE AND DATE:

The Forum will take place on **17th September 2026, from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm** in **[Maria.O1 venue \(Lapinlahdenkatu 16, 00180 Helsinki, Finland\)](#)**.

4. OBLIGATIONS OF THE ORGANISERS:

The Organisers, by virtue of these legal terms of participation in the Forum, undertake the following commitments towards the Participating and/or Finalist Companies:

- Adequately publicise the call and Forum details through official channels and other media. FSJD will disseminate information through the usual i4KIDS network channels.
- Guarantee accessibility to the necessary information about the Forum, including legal terms, requirements, and deadlines.
- Validate the documentation submitted by companies and verify compliance with the requirements set forth in these legal terms.
- Communicate, within the indicated deadlines, the results of the selection process to both selected and non-selected companies.

5. CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION:

- Participating Companies may submit applications from **4th May 2026, until 1st June 2026 at 23.59h CET** by filling out the form available at: **<https://forms.gle/tumv1rNrQyFcLQSp6>**

- Companies must be legally incorporated prior to **4th May 2026**.
- Companies must be seeking pre-seed or seed investment.
- Participating Companies must have the project under development in the field of paediatric and/or maternal health.
- Companies must have their registered office in Europe, or a subsidiary's headquarters in Europe. Projects developed in countries that are part of the European Economic Area, the Council of Europe, and the European Union, including the UK and Switzerland, will be considered valid.
- To formalise registration, Participating Companies must complete the online form, attaching the required project documentation and these signed legal terms.
- Each participating company represents and warrants that all information submitted or presented is true, accurate, and not misleading, and that it has full authority to disclose such information. Each company acknowledges and agrees that it is solely responsible for the content provided.
- A selection committee ("**Evaluation Committee**"), consisting of one or two expert members from each of the Organisers and one member from a Collaborating Entity, will select the Finalist Companies. During the selection process (June 2026), the Evaluation Committee may contact Participating Companies for interviews, clarifications, or additional project information.

Members of the Evaluation Committee will act independently and impartially. Any member who has a direct or indirect personal, professional, or financial interest in a Participating Company shall disclose such conflict and abstain from participating in the evaluation and selection of that company.

- Applications will be excluded if they:
 - are not in the field of paediatrics and/or maternal health,

- harm the environment or local surroundings,
- have a corporate object contrary to the corporate object or code of ethics of one of the Organisers,
- are not seeking funding.

Results will be communicated to Participating Companies during the first week of July 2026.

Finalist Companies will present their project (5–7 minutes pitch) to investors at the Forum. A panel of investors may ask questions, and other investors or attendees may also be present as observers.

Finalist Companies must commit to pitching in person in Helsinki on the Forum date (unless force majeure justifies an online pitch).

6. TIMELINE:

- Applications: 4th May 2026 - 1st June 2026 at 23.59h CET
- Evaluation of applications: June 2026
- Announcement of selected projects: First week of July 2026
- Presentation of selected projects at the Forum: **17th September 2026, from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm (in Helsinki)**

7. MEMBERSHIP IN INVESTOR NETWORKS:

Finalist Companies must join the **CoMB MedAngels Investor Network** (by accepting the corresponding Membership Terms) once they are notified of their selection.

The **CoMB MedAngels Investor Network** Membership Terms specify that if a Finalist Company secures investment through the CoMB MedAngels Investor Network within 24 months of introduction to investors, the Network will be entitled to fees equivalent to 4% (plus VAT) of private funds obtained, with a minimum of €2,000 (plus VAT) (the “**Fees**”).

Therefore, all Participating Companies must accept these LEGAL TERMS, but only Finalist Companies must accept **CoMB MedAngels Investor Network Membership Terms** to present at the Forum (when informed that they have been selected by the Organisers). Upon request, complete Membership Terms can be

provided. The most relevant clause (the Fees) has already been expressly included in these Legal Terms. For this reason, it is not considered that there is any impediment for the Finalist Companies to accept the Legal Terms, since they will have already been informed of this condition. 8. INTELLECTUAL AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY:

The intellectual and industrial property rights of each project belong to the company owning the project.

9. CONFIDENTIALITY:

By registering, Participating Companies accept that information shared in the application will be accessible to the Forum Organisers and Collaborating Entities, who undertake strict confidentiality and will not use or disclose it except as necessary for organising the Forum.

Instead, the Participating Companies, with their registration, accept that they **CANNOT** share confidential information about their projects in the public presentation that will be made on the day of the Forum, in the case of being selected, since it will be information accessible by the possible investors, by the other entrepreneurs/participants in the Forum, and by other possible attendees. All the information they share will be done under their sole responsibility, exempting in any case the Organisers of the Forum from the possible consequences that may arise from the fact of sharing confidential information in the presentation.

For the purpose of facilitating investor review and the organisation of 1-1 meetings, Finalists Companies acknowledge and agree that a non-confidential pitch deck submitted as part of the application process (which must be expressly marked as non-confidential) may be shared with a selected pool of investors participating in the Forum. Such sharing will be limited to the preparation and evaluation of potential investment opportunities within the context of the Forum.

10. IMAGE RIGHTS:

The Organisers may disseminate the event on their websites and social media. Participating Companies authorize the capture, editing, reproduction, and public

use of their image on the Organisers' websites, social media, and related platforms, without time or territorial limitation, always respecting personal honour and privacy and in accordance with current legislation, solely for promotion of the Forum.

11. LIABILITY:

The Organisers are not responsible for the decisions of investors regarding Participating Companies, nor for any future agreements between companies and investors. The Organisers are exempt from any liability arising from such decisions.

Submitting the application implies full acceptance of these legal terms, which constitute the only agreement between Organisers and Participating Companies.

12. DATA PROTECTION:

In accordance with Article 19 of Organic Law 3/2018, of December 5, on personal data protection and digital rights, the personal data of representatives of Participating Companies will be processed by the Organisers and Collaborating Entities solely as company contact data for the purpose of participating in the Forum. Appropriate technical and organisational measures will be applied to ensure data security and prevent unauthorized access, alteration, or loss, in line with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR). Data will be retained only as long as necessary and to fulfil legal obligations.

13. GENERAL TERMS:

Acceptance of these legal terms is unconditional and subject to the Organisers' authority to resolve any issues arising from them.

By participating, companies authorize the Organisers to use their name, surname, and image used in the Forum without entitlement to compensation. Refusal implies automatic withdrawal from the Forum.
